

**ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2006 - 2007 OF RTN. A. PRADHAN, IPS, (PAST PRESIDENT, ROTARY CLUB OF SHILLONG)**

1. On Aug. 25, 2006, organized an HIV & AIDS programme (Galvanizing responses to HIV&AIDS, addressed by Neelima Mathur, Co-ordinator in Foundation For Responsible Media (FORMEDIA).
2. On July, 2006, organised programme of 'Wine Talk' addressed by Rajesh Swarnakar
3. On Sept. 5, 2006, during the Teacher's Day, some of the oldest teachers of Shillong were felicitated by Rotary Club of Shllong.
4. On Oct. 27, 2006 Ms. Binalakshmi Nephram, Advisor of Oxfam GB's South Asia's Control Arms policy' delivered, a thought-provoking talk on 'South Asia's Fractured Frontier', addressing the interlink issues of arms conflict, narcotics and small arms proliferation in the North East. The same day, Ms. Hasina Kharbhih, Founder President of Impulse NGO Network, an organization for Child Rights issues, especially Child Labour and combating trafficking of Children and women, gave an overview of her Impulse NGO Network.
5. On Nov. 10, 2006 & Nov. 27, 2006, erected 2 (two) Welcome signboards on NH-44 in this month linking Guwahati to Silchar via Shillong.
6. On Dec. 2, 2006, 100 (one hundred) warm blankets were distributed to the really poor and needy people of 4 (four) localities of Pomlakrai village, viz. Mawtharia, Rangbihbih, Mawbynna & Pdeng Shnong.
7. On Dec. 26, 2006, Rice, pork, vegetables and oil were distributed to the Orphans of 2 homes, viz. William E.Lewis Boys' Home at Mawphlang and A.W. Thomas Girls' Home at Jaiaw Lumsyntiew.
8. On Jan. 25, 2007, distributed food packets to over 200 poor patients, scattered in the various of wards of Civil Hospital, Shillong.
9. On Jan. 28, 2007, a Health camp was held at SOS children village, Umiam. Over 150 children, in the age group of 3 yrs to 14 yrs were medically examined by doctor of Rotary Club of Shillong. Free medicines were distributed and in many cases, vitamin supplements were added. Also, sweets, cakes and toys were distributed to the children.
10. On Feb. 3, 2007, provided immediate relief (60 warms blankets, 1 quintal of rice, 50 Kgs of dal) to the 30 members of a joint family of K. Suiting of Lumjingsuk, Madanrting, Shillong, whose double storey house was completely gutted.
11. On May 26, 2007, an amount of Rs. 50,000/- as assistance to HIV/AIDS patients, was handed over to Smt. Mary Roy Choudhury, a representation of United Support Group for Positive People (USGPP).
